

Plaistow Primary School - Pupil Premium Allocation 2011-2012

Under the Government Pupil Premium scheme, Plaistow received £62,952 in 2011/12.

Pupil Premium children are those who are eligible for free school meals or who are looked after children.

The money is used to contribute to the following:

- Year 6 extra 1:1 tuition sessions
- After school booster groups in year 6 and Year 2
- Extra 1:1 tuition for Looked After Children
- Extra teacher in year 5 and year 6
- After school extra curricular clubs and resources
- Breakfast club and resources
- Subsidising cost of residential trips
- Additional Learning Mentor (Part-time)
- An Attendance officer (Part-time)
- Teaching Assistants to deliver additional small group support in Year 5 and Year 6
- Teaching Assistants to deliver intervention and group support for reading, writing, maths, speaking and listening
- Every Child Counts teacher

Measuring the impact of Pupil Premium Grant spending

The results for Plaistow pupils finishing Year 2 and Year 6 in 2012 show those children who were eligible for free school meals achieved at higher levels in Reading, Writing and Maths than similar children nationally.
