

## Plaistow Primary School - Pupil Premium Allocation 2012-2013

Under the Government Pupil Premium scheme, Plaistow received £108,333 in 2012/13. Pupil Premium children are those who are eligible for free school meals or who are looked after children.

### **The money is used to contribute to the following:**

- Year 6 extra 1:1 tuition sessions
- After school booster groups in year 6 and Year 2
- Extra 1:1 tuition for Looked After Children
- Extra teacher in year 4, year 5 and year 6
- After school extra- curricular clubs and resources
- Breakfast club and resources
- Subsidising cost of residential trips
- Subsidising the cost of educational visits
- Additional Learning Mentor (Part-time)
- An Attendance officer (full-time)
- Teaching Assistants to deliver additional small group support across the school
- Teaching Assistants to deliver intervention and group support for reading, writing, maths, speaking and listening
- Teaching Assistants to deliver 15-mins a day catch up reading
- Additional staff in nursery and reception classes
- Every Child Counts teacher (autumn term)

### **Measuring the impact of Pupil Premium Grant spending:**

The results for Plaistow pupils finishing year 2 and Year 6 in 2013 show those children who were eligible for free school meals achieved higher levels in Reading, Writing and Maths than similar children nationally.
